Brule County Deputy Director of Equalization

Brule County will be taking applications for the Deputy Director of Equalization position.

The Deputy Director of Equalization is required to have a CAA(Certified Appraiser Assessor) designation through the Department of Revenue within one year of appointment.

Recertification is required every five years and is accomplished by attending annual school and passing prescribed courses, attending conferences and workshops sponsored by the South Dakota Association of Assessing Officers and the South Dakota Department of Revenue.

Strong computer skills and understand of legal descriptions, basic math, knowledge of GIS maps, valid driver's license, knowledge and ability to operate measuring tools, office equipment and prepare reports.
